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VisionX navigation tools consist of icons, keyboard keys, and menus. Icons are buttons which you click to tell the program to perform a certain function. Most of these buttons have a Keyboard equivalent executing the same function. You can either press the keys on your keyboard or click the icons in the window. You may already be familiar with some of the keystrokes which are standard with other programs. The functions performed by icons or keystrokes may also be activated from the 'Commands' menu.

Keyboard Commands

TAB Moves the cursor to the next field. If you tab after the last field, the cursor moves back to

the first field of the open window.

SHIFT-TAB Moves the cursor to the previous field. If you shift-tab off the first field, the cursor moves

to the last field of the open window.

ENTER Saves the information entered on the screen. You can also use the Save button when

displayed.

In most cases the RETURN key will have the same effect as the ENTER key. However if the cursor is in a multi-line text field, the RETURN key moves the cursor to the next line

of this field adding a blank line below the existing text.

It is a good practice to avoid using the RETURN as a Save equivalent.

List Sorting

Some of the list screens offer several sorting preferences. The active sorting field is the column with an underlined heading. When additional sorting fields are available their headings are not underlined. By clicking any of these headings will prompt VisionX to display the current list according to the new sort field (index).

Lookup Files

Throughout the program you will be able to search lookup files. VisionX allows you to implement the search by entering the start of a record ID (or account number), or the start of its name. You may also display the complete list of all records within the file.

As an example the Invoices screen will allow you to search the Customers and the Products files. When the cursor is in the Customer field, you may:

- leave the field blank and click the Lookup button to display a list of the entire customer file.
- enter the first characters of the customer ID/Account and click the Lookup button, or hit the TAB key, to display a list of all the customers whose ID starts with these first characters.
- enter the first characters of the customer name and click the Lookup button, or hit the TAB key, to display a list of all the customers whose name starts with these characters.
- enter the exact ID of the customer to directly load his/her data.

Once the list of matching records is displayed you may either double-click on the desire record, or highlight its line and hit the TAB key to load the record's data.
